Before completing this Form of Proxy, please read carefully the Notice of Court Meeting (including the notes thereto) set out in Part 10 of the scheme document of The Forest Company Limited (the "**Company**") dated 5 August 2024 (the "**Scheme Document**") which has been sent to shareholders and the Notes set out overleaf. By an order dated 24 July 2024 made in the matter of the Company and in the matter of Part VIII of the Companies (Guernsey) Law, 2008 (as amended) (the "**Companies Law**"), the Royal Court of Guernsey has directed for a meeting (the "**Court Meeting**") to be convened of the Scheme Shareholders (as defined in the Scheme referred to below) for the purpose of considering and, if thought fit, approving (with or without modification) a scheme of arrangement pursuant to Part VIII of the Companies Law proposed to be made between the Company and the Scheme Shareholders (the "**Scheme**") and that such meeting will be held at the offices of Vistra Fund Services (Guernsey) Limited at, 4th Floor, Royal Bank Place, Gategny Esplanade, St Peter Port, Guernsey GY1 2HJ on 16 August 2024 at 10.00 a.m. (Guernsey time) at which place and time all Scheme Shareholders are requested to attend.

Notes

1. Terms defined in the Scheme Document shall apply equally in this form unless the context otherwise requires. Full details of the resolution to be proposed at the Court Meeting (which will be taken on a poll) are set out in the Notice of Court Meeting contained in Part 10 of the Scheme Document (the "Notice"). Before completing this form, please read the Notice in full (including the notes thereto) and also read in full the sections entitled "ACTION TO BE TAKEN" set out on pages 9 to 10, and in paragraph 11 of Part 2 (*Explanatory Statement*), of the Scheme Document.
2. Only Scheme Shareholders, or their duly appointed proxies or corporate representatives, are entitled to attend, speak and vote at the Court Meeting.
3. Every Scheme Shareholder has the right to appoint some other person(s) of their choice, who need not be a shareholder, as their proxy to exercise all or any of their rights to attend, speak and vote on their behalf at the Court Meeting. If you wish to appoint the Chairman of the meeting as your sole proxy in respect of all your Scheme Shares, simply sign in the relevant box to indicate how you wish your vote to be cast and date the Form of Proxy. If you wish to appoint a person other than the Chairman of the meeting as your sole proxy in respect of all of your Scheme Shares, delete the words 'the Chairman of the meeting or' and insert the name of your proxy in the space provided, then sign in the relevant box to indicate how you wish your vote to be cast and date the Form of Proxy. If the proxy is being appointed in relation to less than your full voting entitlement, please enter in the box next to the proxy holder's name the number of shares in relation to which they are authorised to act as your proxy. If returned without an indication as to how the proxy shall vote on the matter, this form shall be invalid. Your proxy will vote as you indicate. For any other business arising at the Court Meeting (including any proper procedural resolution not listed in the Notice) your proxy will vote at their discretion. Your proxy must attend the Court Meeting in person.
4. You may appoint more than one proxy in relation to the Court Meeting provided that each proxy is appointed to exercise the rights attaching to (a) different Scheme Share(s) held by you. To appoint more than one proxy, (an) additional Form(s) of Proxy may be obtained by contacting the Company's registrar, Vistra Fund Services (Guernsey) Limited (the "Registrar") at the address or via the shareholder helpline detailed at note 14 or you may photocopy this form. Please indicate in the box next to the proxy holder's name the number of shares in relation to which they are authorised to act as your proxy. Please also indicate by marking the box provided if the proxy instruction is one of multiple instructions being given. All forms must be signed and should be returned together in the same envelope.
5. Entitlement to attend, speak and vote at the Court Meeting and the number of votes which may be cast thereat will be determined by reference to the register of members of the Company at 6.00 p.m. (Guernsey time) on the day which is two Business Days before the day of the Court Meeting or any adjournment thereof. Changes to entries on the register of members after that time shall be disregarded in determining the rights of any person to attend, speak and vote at the Court Meeting.
6. Where there is more than one proxy appointed and the total number of shares in respect of which proxies are appointed is no greater than the member's entire holding, it is assumed that proxies are appointed in relation to different shares, rather than that conflicting appointments have been made in relation to the same shares. There is only assumed to be a conflict where the aggregate number of shares in respect of which proxies have been appointed exceeds the member's entire holding. If you return more than one proxy appointment, the appointment received last by the Registrar before the latest time for the receipt of proxies will take precedence. Proxies in the same envelope will be treated as sent and received at the same time, to minimize the number of conflicting proxies. If conflicting proxies are sent or received at the same time or if the Registrar is unable to determine which was sent or received last in respect of (or deemed to be in respect of) an entire holding, none of them shall be treated as valid.
7. To be valid this Form of Proxy, together with any power of attorney or other authority under which it is signed (or a duly certified copy thereof), must be returned by post to Vistra Fund Services (Guernsey) Limited at, 4th Floor, Royal Bank Place, Glatigny Esplanade, St Peter Port, Guernsey GY1 2HJ or by email to forest.gg@vistra.com, to be received not less than 48 hours before the time of holding the Court Meeting or, as the case may be, the adjourned Court Meeting. If this Form of Proxy is not returned by the relevant time, it may be handed to the Chairman of the meeting to be received before the start of the Court Meeting, and will still be valid.
8. Overleaf is how your address appears on the register of members of the Company. If this information is incorrect, please contact the Registrar to request a change of address form at the address or via the shareholder helpline detailed at note 14.
9. Any alterations made to this form should be initialed.
10. The completion and return of this form will not preclude a shareholder from attending, speaking and voting at the meeting in person. If a member appoints a proxy or proxies and then decides to attend the Court Meeting in person and vote on a poll using their poll card, then the vote in person will override the proxy vote(s). If the vote in person is in respect of the member's entire holding then all proxy votes will be disregarded. If, however, the member votes at the meeting in respect of less than the member's entire holding, and the member indicates on their polling card that all proxies are to be disregarded, that shall be the case; but if the member does not specifically revoke proxies, then the vote in person will be treated in the same way as if it were the last received proxy and earlier proxies will only be disregarded to the extent that to count them would result in the number of votes being cast exceeding the member's entire holding.
11. In the case of a Scheme Shareholder which is a company, any Form of Proxy must be executed under its common seal or signed on its behalf by a duly authorised officer of the company or an attorney or other person duly authorised for the company.
12. As an alternative to appointing a proxy, any corporation which is a Scheme Shareholder can appoint one or more corporate representatives who may exercise on its behalf all of its rights to attend, speak and vote at the Court Meeting provided that they do not do so in relation to the same Scheme Shares.
13. In the case of joint holders of Scheme Shares, only the joint holder who has been elected by such joint holders to represent them shall be entitled to vote, whether in person or by proxy. In the absence of any such election, the joint holder whose name stands first in the Register in respect of the joint holding shall alone be entitled to vote.
14. To allow effective constitution of the meeting, if it is apparent to the Chairman that no shareholders of the Company will be present in person or by proxy, other than the Chairman and by proxy in the Chairman's favour, then the Chairman may appoint a substitute to act as proxy in their stead for any shareholder, provided that such substitute proxy shall vote on the same basis as the Chairman.
16. By the order of the court, the Royal Court of Guernsey has appointed Howard Myles, or failing him, Rainer Häggblom, or failing him, any other director of the Company, to act as Chairman of the Court Meeting and has directed the Chairman of the Court Meeting to report the result thereof to the Court.
